- MJ Alone Sentencing
- Uniform Application
- Sentencing Parameters & Criteria Board
 - Statutory Directive?



NDAA 2022, Cont'd

- Sentencing Parameters
 - Typical Violation of the Offense
 - Severity of the offense
 - Similar Federal Guideline/other guidelines
 - Any military-specific sentencing factors
 - Sufficiently Broad to allow for individualized consideration
 - No less than 5 no more than 12
- Criteria Offenses
- >10 months to implement



Criteria Offenses

The nature of the offense is indeterminate and unsuitable for categorization; and there is no similar criminal offense under the laws of the United States or the laws of the District of Columbia

Article 94. Mutiny or sedition.

The age and experience of the accused;

Any mental impairment or deficiency of the accused;

The accused's relationship to the military or civil authority against which the accused committed the mutiny or sedition;

Whether the offense disrupted or, in any way, impacted the operations of any organization;

Whether the offense was committed to avoid the movement of a vessel or hazardous duty or shirk important service;

Whether the offense was committed before or in the presence of the enemy;

Whether the offense caused damage to the national security of the United States, regardless of whether the accused intended such damage;

Whether the accused was the actual perpetrator of the offense or was a principal whose participation in the offense was major;

Whether the accused was an organizer, leader, manager, or supervisor in the

Parameters Applied:

- Offenses committed after 27 December 23
- Confinement only
- Must sentence within the confinement range, unless MJ finds specific facts that warrant a sentence outside the range
- Plea Agreements
 - agreement controls, but if outside a range MJ may reject agreement if plainly unreasonable

Rational & Critiques

- Not Federal Guidelines
- Broad
 - Lack of Concise Data
 - limit noise w/out injecting bias or unfair advantages/disadvantages
 - Embraces Discretion of MJ as an Attribute vs. "Fear of Judging"
 - MJRG Phased Approach
- What about other Noisy Areas?
