- Oldest Federal Prison in U.S. in Continuous Operation
- Only Maximum Security Prison in Department of Defense
- Accredited by the American Correctional Association (ACA) Since 1988
- Last Execution 1961
- Last Disturbance 2010
- Last Escape 1998

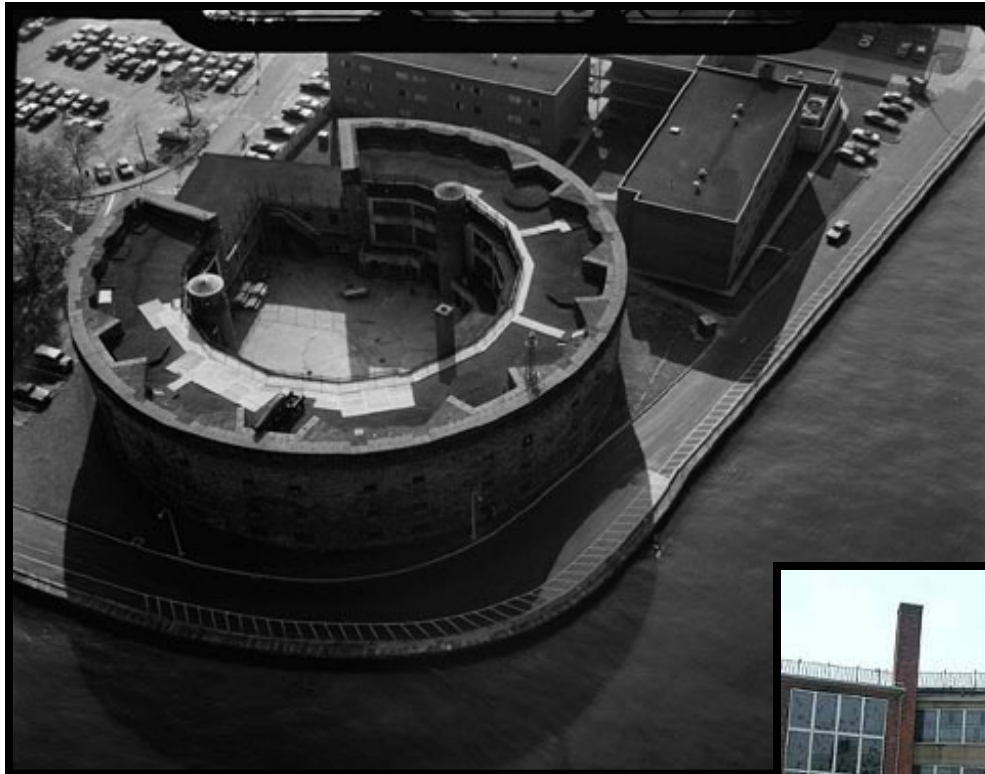

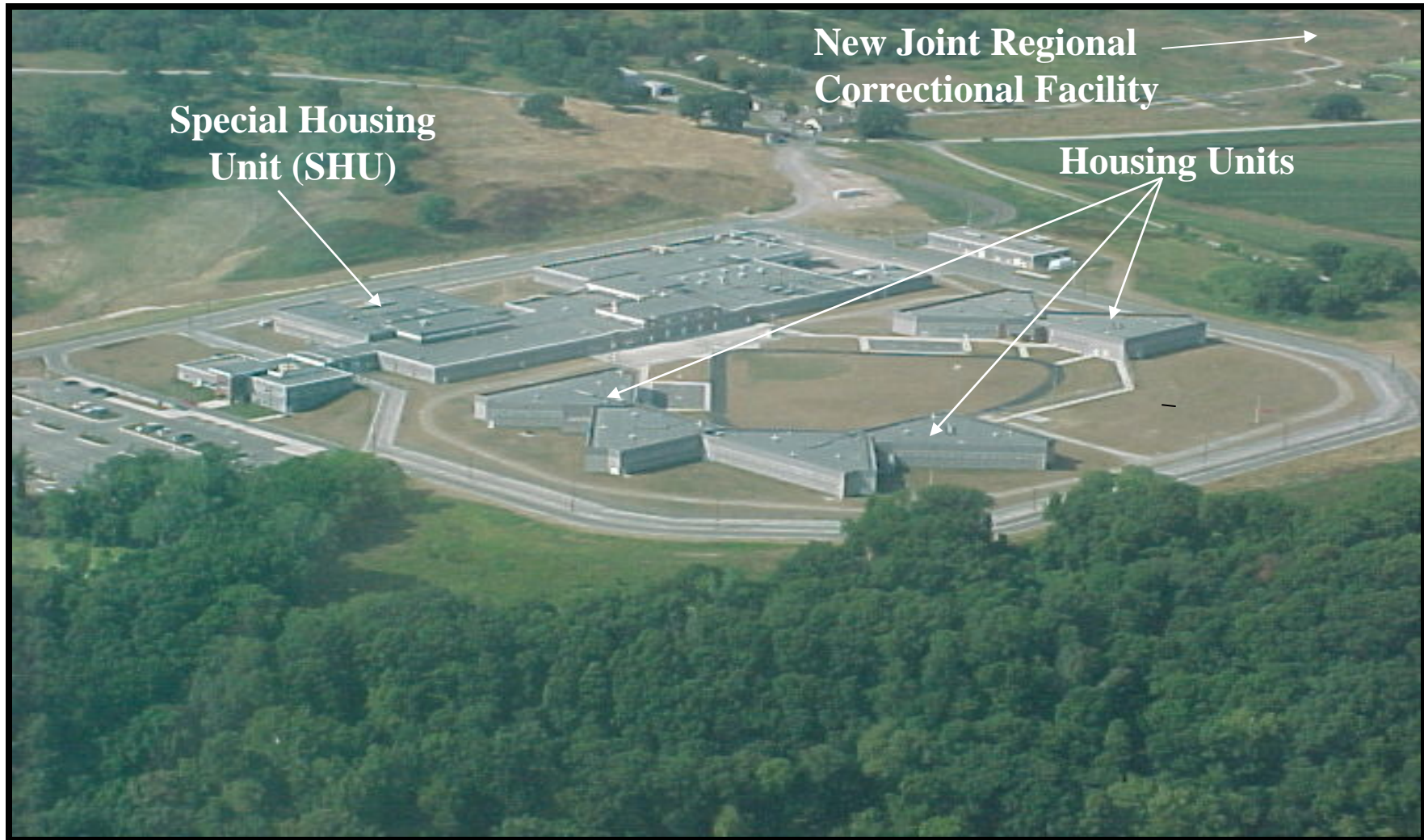

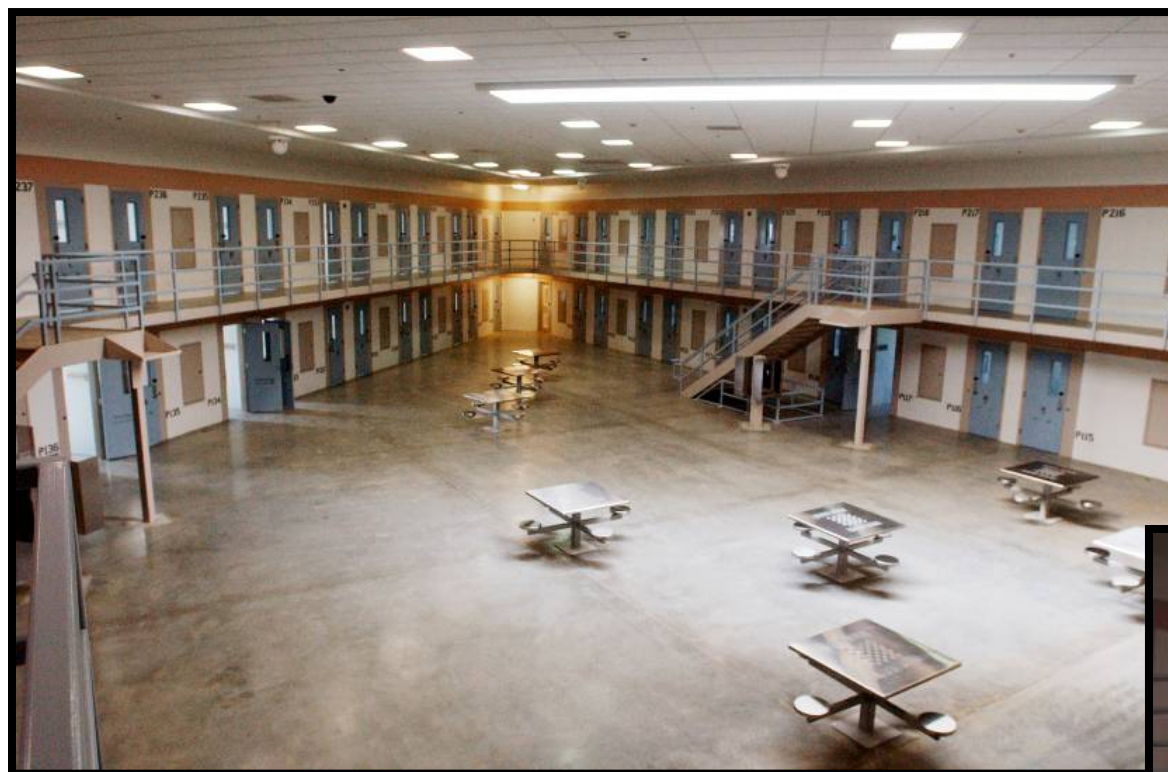


Completed in Aug 2002; 1<sup>st</sup> inmates arrived Sept 2002; \$67.8 million; maximum of 515 cells

## Assessment Division:

- Conducts Archival Research
- Assesses Internal and External Risk
- Develops Risk Assessment Management Plan (Links Classification to Risk Assessment)

## Mental Health Division:

- Conducts Psychometric Tests to Assess Inmate Functioning
- Treats all Mentally Ill Inmates
- Coordinates Psychiatric Services

## Rehabilitation Division:

- Coordinates Treatment Groups
  - Victim Impact Education
  - Reasoning and Rehabilitation
  - Anger Management
  - Chemical Abuse and Addiction Program
  - Assaultive Offenders Program
  - Sex Offenders Treatment Program
- Coordinates Self Growth Programs
  - Alcoholics Anonymous
  - Narcotics Anonymous

# Parole and Clemency



- USDB Recommends - Service Clemency And Parole Boards Decide
- Military Prisoners Eligible For Parole After 1/3 Of Sentence
- 87 Inmates On Military Parole/114 Federal Parole
- Military Inmates In FBOP And On Parole Considered For Clemency Annually
- 54 Inmates On Military MSR/10 Federal MSR
