SUBJECT: Financial Aid Policy for the 2026 Continuing Legal Education and Training Program of the United States Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces

1. The U.S. Court of Appeals for the Armed Forces has adopted this financial aid policy for attorneys who wish to attend the 2026 Continuing Legal Education and Training Program but are unable to attend because of cost considerations.
2. Unemployed attorneys (other than retired attorneys receiving retired military pay) and attorneys with annual incomes of \$50,000 or less are eligible for a fee waiver or discount as indicated in the following chart:

| | |
|-----------------------------|--------------|
| Unemployed | Full waiver |
| Income up to \$35,000 | 75% discount |
| Income \$35,000 to \$50,000 | 50% discount |
| Income above \$50,000 | No discount |

3. To apply for a fee waiver or discount, an attorney must send a letter by email to USCAAFCLE@armfor.uscourts.gov no later than 7 days before the start of the conference. The letter must state the attorney's bar membership status, employment status, and annual income. The letter must be signed and dated.
